report as Chairman since my appointment on 29th May, 2020 and the ninth Annual Report of the

Board.

The Property Services Appeal Board has been included within the provisions of sections 29 and 31 of

the Civil Law and Criminal Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 2020 which provide for remote hearing

of appeals. I welcome this as it provides the Board with assurance to conduct remote hearings of

appeals.

The Board would also welcome an amendment to the legislation which would statutorily require the

appellant to include a copy of the decision when appealing. This will assist in clarifying that the

appeal has been received within the 30 day limitation period in accordance with the Act of 2011.

I wish to thank my fellow Board members, for their hard work and dedication in 2022 where the

Board convened on 22 occasions often at short notice to deal with issues urgently arising. The Board

also dealt with issues including Governance, Risk Management, Data Protection, Freedom of

Information requests, Training and taking professional advices. I also wish to express my

appreciation to the Board Secretary, Ms Kathleen Fitzpatrick, for all the hard work and diligence in

preparation and execution of all board business arising. The Board have also asked me to express

their appreciation for your support and that of your Department and its officials.

1. Period covered by this report

This report covers the period from 1st January, 2022 to 31st December, 2022. This is the ninth annual report to the Minister for Justice as required under Schedule 5, at paragraph 11, of the *Property Services (Regulation) Act 2011*.

2. Caseload data on appeals received

The volume of cases considered and decided during the period covered by this report was 31.

Of the 31 appeals received and completed during 2022

- 25 appeals were disallowed and the Board affirmed the decision of the Authority;
- 1 appeal was withdrawn by the Appellant,
- 1 appeal was part allowed and part disallowed,
- 1 appeal was part remitted and part allowed,
- 2 appeals were referred back to the Authority for reconsideration.

Note: We had 1 appeal on hand awaiting decision - listed for hearing on the 9th Feb 2023.

Appointments to the Appeal Board are for a four year term with provision for appointment for a second or subsequent term. The Board would suggest that future appointments should involve a staggered expiry of Warrants to assist continuity of expertise and familiarity with the legislation.

Payments to Members of the Appeal Board are made in accordance with paragraph 5 of Schedule 5 of the Act at Section 5 as set out below:

5. Members of the Appeal Board shall be paid such remuneration (if any) and allowances for expenses as the Minister, with the consent of the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform, may determine.

Fees are not paid for Membership of the Board *per se* but for participation in sittings of the Board. The rates, which are subject to tax and statutory deductions per sitting where that Member is in attendance are set out below:

Chairperson €500 per sitting

Ordinary Member €416 per sitting

Board fees and expenses for 2022 including all costs and outlay incurred totalled € 54,105.

4. Meetings

There were 22 Board meetings during 2022 which consisted of appeals hearings, corporate governance, risk management, training, Freedom of Information requests, GDPR and further professional advices.

1. An tréimhse lena mbaineann an tuarascáil seo

Baineann an tuarascáil seo leis an tréimhse ón 1 Eanáir 2022 go dtí an 31 Nollaig 2022. Is í seo an naoú tuarascáil bhliantúil atá á cur faoi bhráid an Aire Dlí agus Cirt mar a éilítear faoi Sceideal 5, ag alt 11 den *Acht um Sheirbhísí Maoine (Rialáil), 2011*.

2. Sonraí maidir le líon na gcásanna a fuarthas

Ba 31 cás a breithníodh agus a cinneadh le linn thréimhse na tuarascála seo.

As na 31 achomharc a fuarthas agus a tugadh chun críche le linn 2022

- dícheadaíodh 25 achomharc agus dhearbhaigh an Bord cinneadh an Údaráis;
- tharraing an tAchomharcóir siar 1 achomharc,
- ceadaíodh i bpáirt agus dícheadaíodh i bpáirt 1 achomharc,
- tarchuireadh i bpáirt agus ceadaíodh i bpáirt 1 achomharc,
- cuireadh 2 achomharc faoi bhráid an Údaráis arís lena mbreithniú.

Nóta: Bhí 1 achomharc amháin ar lámh agus ar feitheamh cinnidh - liostaithe lena éisteacht ar an 9 Feabhra 2023.

Ceapadh Orla Coyne Uasal chuig an mBord ar feadh théarma ceithre bliana le héifeacht ón 29 Márta 2022.

Is téarma ceithre bliana atá sna ceapacháin chuig an mBord Achomhairc agus soláthar ann do cheapachán don dara téarma nó do théarma ina dhiaidh sin. Mholfadh an Bord go mbeadh Barántais in éag ar bhonn céimnithe ag baint le ceapacháin amach anseo chun go mbeidh fáil leanúnach ar dhaoine a bhfuil saineolas agus cur amach acu ar an dlí.

Déantar íocaíochtaí le Comhaltaí an Bhoird Achomhairc de réir alt 5 i Sceideal 5 den Acht in Alt 5 thíos:

5. Íocfar le comhaltaí an Bhoird Achomhairc cibé luach saothair (más ann) agus liúntais i leith caiteachas a chinnfidh an tAire, le toiliú an Aire Caiteachais Phoiblí agus Athchóirithe.

Ní íoctar táillí *per se* as Comhaltacht ar an mBord ach íoctar iad as bheith rannpháirteach i suíonna an Bhoird. Is mar seo a leanas na rátaí, atá faoi réir ag cáin agus asbhaintí reachtúla, a íoctar le Comhalta a fhreastalaíonn ar shuí:

€500 in aghaidh an tsuí don Chathaoirleach €416 in aghaidh an tsuí don Ghnáthchomhalta

Is ionann táillí agus costais an Bhoird don bhliain 2022 lena n-áirítear gach costas agus caiteachas tabhaithe agus € 54,105.

4. Cruinnithe

22 cruinniú Boird a tionóladh i rith na bliana 2022 a bhí comhdhéanta d'éisteachtaí achomhairc, rialachas corparáideach, bainistiú rioscaí, oiliúint, iarrataí faoin Acht um Shaoráil Faisnéise, GDPR agus comhairlí gairmiúla eile.

5. Rialachas agus Comhlíonadh

Aithníonn Comhaltaí an Bhoird na freagrachtaí a leagtar orthu faoi théarmaí an Chóid Cleachtais chun Comhlachtaí Stáit a Rialú.

Tugann an Bord faoi oiliúint forbartha gairmiúla chun seachadadh seirbhíse ceart agus éifeachtaí a chinntiú maidir le déileáil le cinntí a ndéantar achomharc ina leith a láimhseáil.
